Please follow the instructions that are given below in order to turn off the **MySQL Strict Mode**.



NOTE: Make the following changes in the my.ini (for Windows Operating System) or my.cnf (for Linux Operating System):

1. Look for the following line:
`sql-mode = "STRICT_TRANS_TABLES,NO_AUTO_CREATE_USER,NO_ENGINE_SUBSTITUTION"`
2. Change it to:
`sql-mode=""` (Blank)
3. **Restart** the **MySQL Service**.
